

GUIDELINES FOR BUSINESS EVENTS

TRAVELING TO AND FROM DUBAI



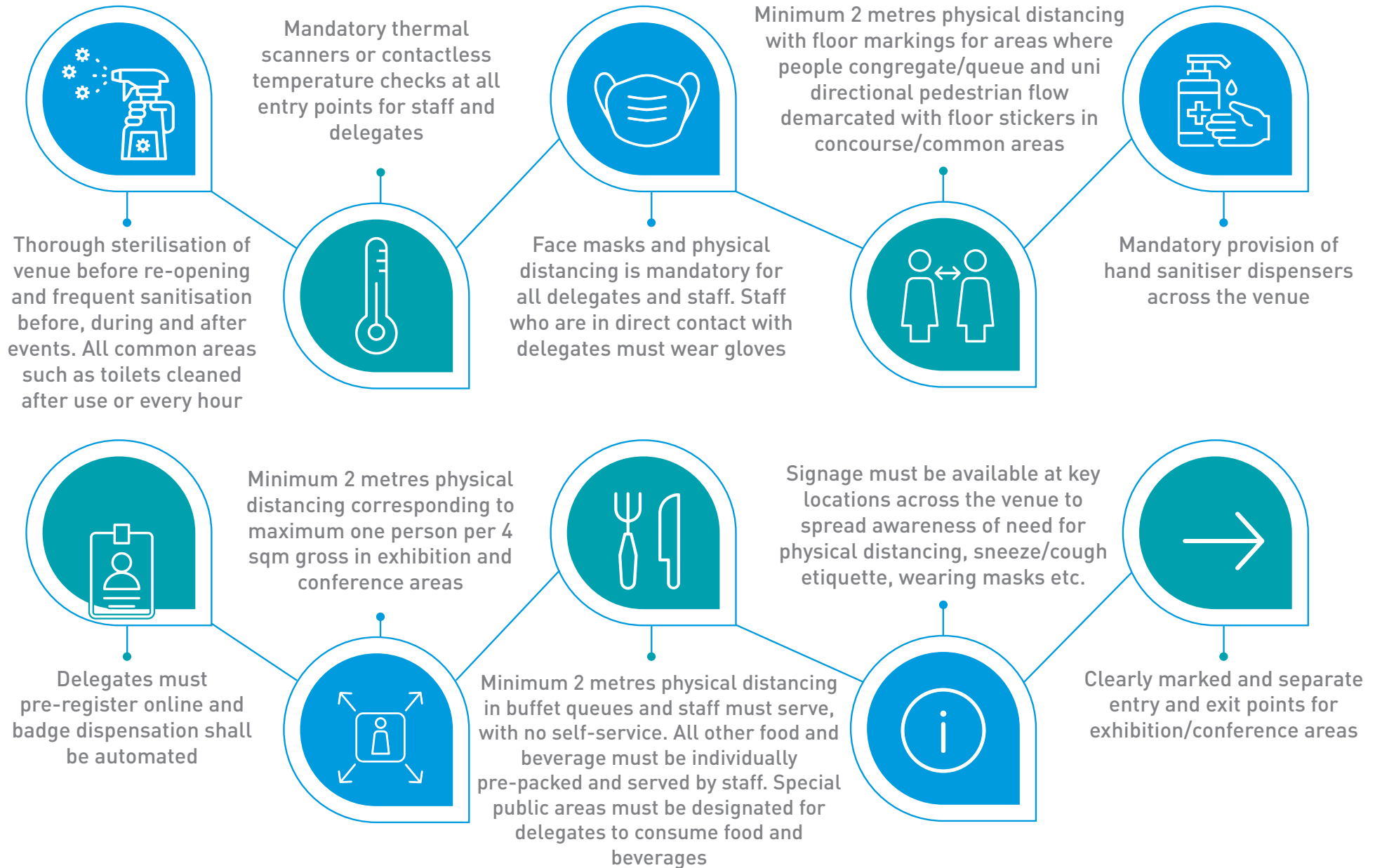
All tourists, residents, citizens and transit passengers must present a negative COVID-19 PCR test certificate to be accepted on a flight to Dubai. The test must be taken a maximum of 96 hours before departure. The test may be taken at any lab accredited by the health authority in the country of departure. Arriving passengers must also complete a Health Declaration Form.

- Measures in place at Dubai International Airport include protective plexiglass at check-in and immigration counters, thermal and temperature screening, social distancing markers and increased levels of sanitisation.
- Tourists are required to download the **COVID19- DXB app**.



- Only valid ticket holders will be allowed into the airport building
- Travellers must not go to the airport more than four hours before their scheduled flight time
- Protective gloves and mask must be worn by all travellers.
- Passengers displaying symptoms are advised to not come to the airport.
- Passengers traveling from Dubai to UK or Europe (and other mandated destinations) are required to take a COVID19- PCR test no more than 96 hours before departure and present the test result certificate at check-in.

Local business events can resume on 15th September 2020 while international business events can resume on 1st October 2020

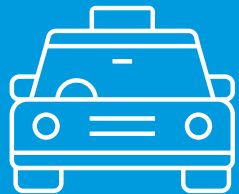
STAYING IN DUBAI



The public are required to strictly follow precautionary measures which include:

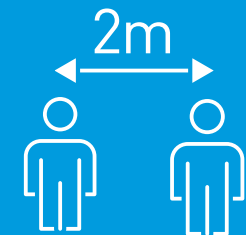
- Maintaining physical distance from others as per guidelines
- Wearing a face mask (can be removed in restaurants) – gloves optional
- Undergoing temperature checks at shopping malls, hotels, attractions etc.

- Hotels are open and continue to operate rigorous sterilization and disinfection procedures.
- Contactless temperature screening for guests before completing check-in.
- Hotel staff are required to go through daily temperature checks and to follow stringent guidelines from Dubai Municipality.
- Mandatory temperature checks for all onsite staff.
- Compulsory wearing of masks for staff who are in direct contact with customers.



Taxi drivers wear face masks and gloves, frequent sanitization of vehicle, maximum two passengers seated at the back and no passenger in front.

- Water parks and pools must implement 2 metres social distancing at all times. Public and private beaches also open and subject to stringent safety procedures.
- Theme parks, amusement parks, cinemas and recreational areas etc. are all operating whilst adhering to safety guidelines issued by Dubai Municipality and Dubai Tourism.
